

Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) are summary documents that provide information about the hazards of a product and advice about safety precautions. Every product that is classified as a "hazardous product" under federal law that is intended for use, handling or storage in a workplace must have an SDS.

USA

Except for the products listed in the tables below, all HeatLink products meet the definition of an "Article" under the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, 29 CFR 1910.1200(b)(6) (v), and are exempt from the requirement to have an SDS and OSHA label.

These products should not present a health or safety hazard under recommended or normal use. However, misuse of these products may affect product performance or present a potential health and safety hazard.

1910.1200(c) Definitions.

Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

Canada

Except for the products listed in the tables below, all HeatLink products meet the definition of a "Manufactured Article" under the Hazardous Products Act (HPA) Section 12 and are exempt from the requirement to have an SDS and WHMIS label.

These products should not present a health or safety hazard under recommended or normal use. However, misuse of these products may affect product performance or present a potential health and safety hazard.

HPA Section 2 - Definitions

Manufactured article means any article that is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture, the intended use of which when in that form is dependent in whole or in part on its shape or design, and that, when being installed, if the intended use of the article requires it to be installed, and under normal conditions of use, will not release or otherwise cause an individual to be exposed to a hazardous product.
